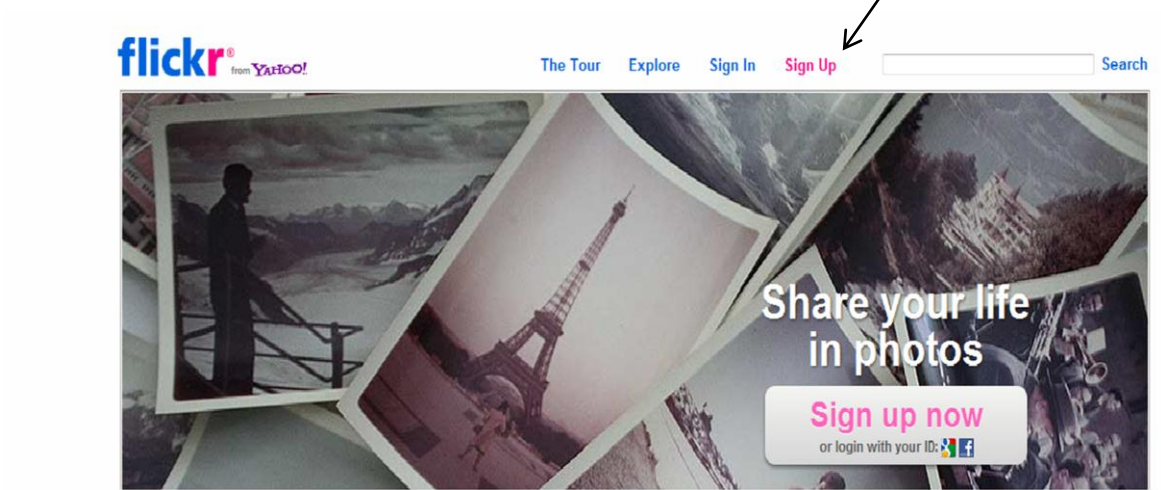
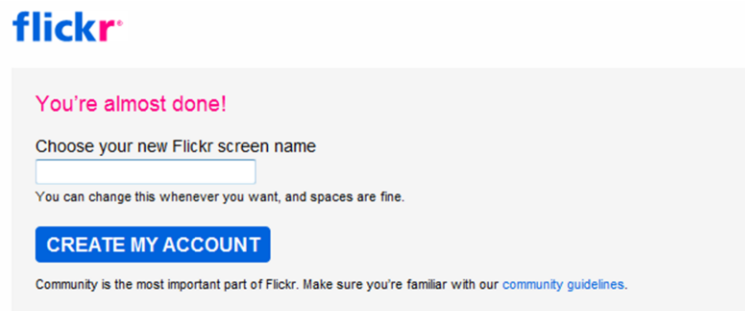


## Want to create a Flickr account? Too easy!

- First of all type in the following web address: <http://www.flickr.com/>
- Once you have accessed the site, click on the button that says “sign up”  
Like so:



- Next simply sign into your yahoo account. If you don't have an account just click the “create new account option”  
This next step is for people that did not have a yahoo account and had to select the “create new account option”
- After selecting to create a new account fill in the details as asked. Once you have filled out your details select create account at the end and confirm your details.
- The last thing you need to do is select a user name! That is the name that you wish for other people to see.
